



### KS1 SATs Results 2015

### Summary KS1

- Last year was the first year 100% of children achieved L1 plus. This trend has continued this year.
- At 2c+ data compares favourably with last years' National figure in Reading, Writing and Maths. In Maths the data is 5% higher than National. All 2c+ attainment measures have increased since last year.
- At 2b+ data compares favourably with last years' National figure in Reading, Writing and Maths. In Maths the data is 8% higher than National. All 2b+ attainment measures have increased since last year.
- At 2a+ data compares favourably with last years' National figure in Reading, Writing and Maths. In Maths the data is 5% higher than National. All 2a+ attainment measures have increased since last year.
- At 3+ data compares favourably with last years' National figure in Reading, Writing and Maths. All 3+ data measures remain in line with last year's figures.

### Summary KS2

- Level 4+ is in line with national in all subjects (Reading, Writing, Maths and Grammar) including level 4 RWM combined.
- Level 5+ although improving is below national in all areas.
- Expected progress is in line or above national in all subjects.
- Better than expected progress in Reading and Maths is in line with national average.
- Better than expected progress in writing is well above national average (+24%).
