Curriculum 2018-19 (Years 3-6)

Pupils from years 3 – 6 will receive one hour of Spanish teaching each week. We aim to encourage Spanish language acquisition through lessons consisting of a range of activities such as group work, speaking practice, games and songs. Lessons will also provide the opportunity for students to learn about the culture and geography of Spain and Latin America. As Spanish is a new subject at Blackley this year, all pupils will start from the same point as on the curriculum below:
