Useful Information

• Drop off and pick up times

For drop off the school gates open at 08.35 and close and 8.45 every morning. Pick up time for our nursery is 3pm and for all other children collection is at 3.15pm. Please ensure that children are dropped off at school at the correct time. Lates will be monitored closely. When dropping your child off at school please ensure they are fully equipped for the day ahead.

Breakfast club

Breakfast club is available from 7.45 each morning, this costs £1 per day. You do not need to sign up for this in advance, arrive at the gate and a member of the breakfast club team will sign the child in.

Medicine

We understand that under some circumstances children need to take medicine during school time. Medicine can be dropped off at the school office at the start of the day. We can accept and administer medication under the following conditions.

- Medicine has to be taken 4 times a day.
- Medicine has been prescribed by a doctor, in its original packaging with the name of the child shown.
- You have completed a medication form which you can collect from the school office.

School Meals

Schools meals are charged at £2.26 per day, unless the child is entitled to free school meals. Payment for meals is due in advance, failure to make regular payments can result in the child no longer being allowed to participate in school meals. Any changes to school meals must be made in writing via the school office.
