

## Nursery – Topic Overview Map

In Spring 1, our Nursery pupils will be learning...



### Literacy

Exploring the text, “And Tango Makes Three”.  
Exploring non fiction texts focusing on winter and weather.

### Communication and Language

Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences. Engage in non-fiction books. Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Play with one or more other children, extending and elaborating play ideas. Find solutions to conflicts and rivalries. Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important.

### Mathematics

Begin to represent numbers in a variety of ways, such as on fingers and using Numicon.  
Begin to separate a group of 3 or 4 objects in different ways recognising that the number is still the same.

### Physical Development

Beginning to use three fingers to hold a writing tool. Drawing a simple shape.  
PE – Dance Focus  
“Can I move like an animal?”

### Understanding the World

Explore and respond to different natural phenomena in their setting and on trips. Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.

“What is the weather like today?”  
“What would we wear?”

### Expressive Arts and Design

Engage in make believe. Join in singing songs. Use tools for a purpose.
