

Useful Information

• Drop off and pick up times

School gates open at 8.35am and close at 8.50am each morning. Gates re-open at 3.15pm for end of day collections. Please ensure children are dropped off and collected on time.

Breakfast club

Breakfast club is available from 7.45am Monday-Friday at a cost of £1 per day. You do not need to sign up in advance. Simply arrive at the hall before 8.30am. The attendance fee will be then forwarded to your child's Parentpay account. You are able to make payment transactions daily or weekly. If you would prefer monthly, this should be relayed with the school office.

Medicine

Medication can be dropped off at the school office at the start of the day. We can accept and administer medication under the following conditions;

- Medicine has to be taken 4 times a day;
- Medicine has been prescribed by a doctor, and is in its original packaging complete with pharmacy labels;
- You have completed a medication form (available from the school office).

School Meals

Schools meals are charged at £2.26 per day, unless the child is entitled to free school meals. Payment for meals to be made via Parentpay. Failure to make regular payments will result in you being asked to provide your child with a packed lunch. Any changes to school meals must be made in writing/email to the school office. If you think you may be entitled to free school meals please make an online application via www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims.
